Chinnaya vs Ramayya - Case Summary

Key Facts:

- Aunty gifts her house to daughter Ramayya on condition she gives Rs.10,000/month to her sister Chinna
- After Aunty's death, Ramayya stops payments.
- Ramayya claims no consideration from Chinnaya.
- Court rules: Consideration can be from promisee or any other person (Indian Contract Act, 1872).

Legal Learning:

- Consideration doesn't need to flow from the promisee.
- Even a third-party benefit can validate a contract in India.
- Chinnaya wins the case based on valid consideration.
